## FLOW of Admission Procedure

### Requirements for Admission ※ Applicants need to fulfill either condition, A or B.

- A** ① Graduated from high school or higher, or the equivalent in their own country.  
② Completed 12-years or more of compulsory education.

- B** ① 6-month or more of Japanese language education at a Japanese language school.  
② A pass in the 1st or 2nd Grade in Japanese Language Proficiency Test.  
③ 200 points or better score in total in the sections of reading comprehension, listening comprehension and listening & reading comprehension in the subject "Japanese as a Foreign Language" in the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU).

### Application Preparation Please follow the steps below as your preparation.

Academic background of high school graduation or equivalent to/higher than that in their own countries  
Completion of a 12-year or over 12-year course of compulsory education

- 1 Contact school of your choice. School checks your eligibility for admission and application documents. Interview date fixed.
- 2 20-minute interview conducted in Japanese to assess your Japanese.
- 3 Submit application form with Certificate of Financial Support, Letter of Guarantee, a Pledge, and 5 photos.
- 4 Be screened by individual school. Screening may differ for each school.
- 5 Receive notification of a pass. But this is not an official acceptance at this point.
- 6 Pay the tuition fees. The amount may differ for each school.
- 7 Wait for the Entrance Permit to be issued.
- 8 Receive the Certificate of Eligibility.
- 9 Participate in the Entrance Ceremony.

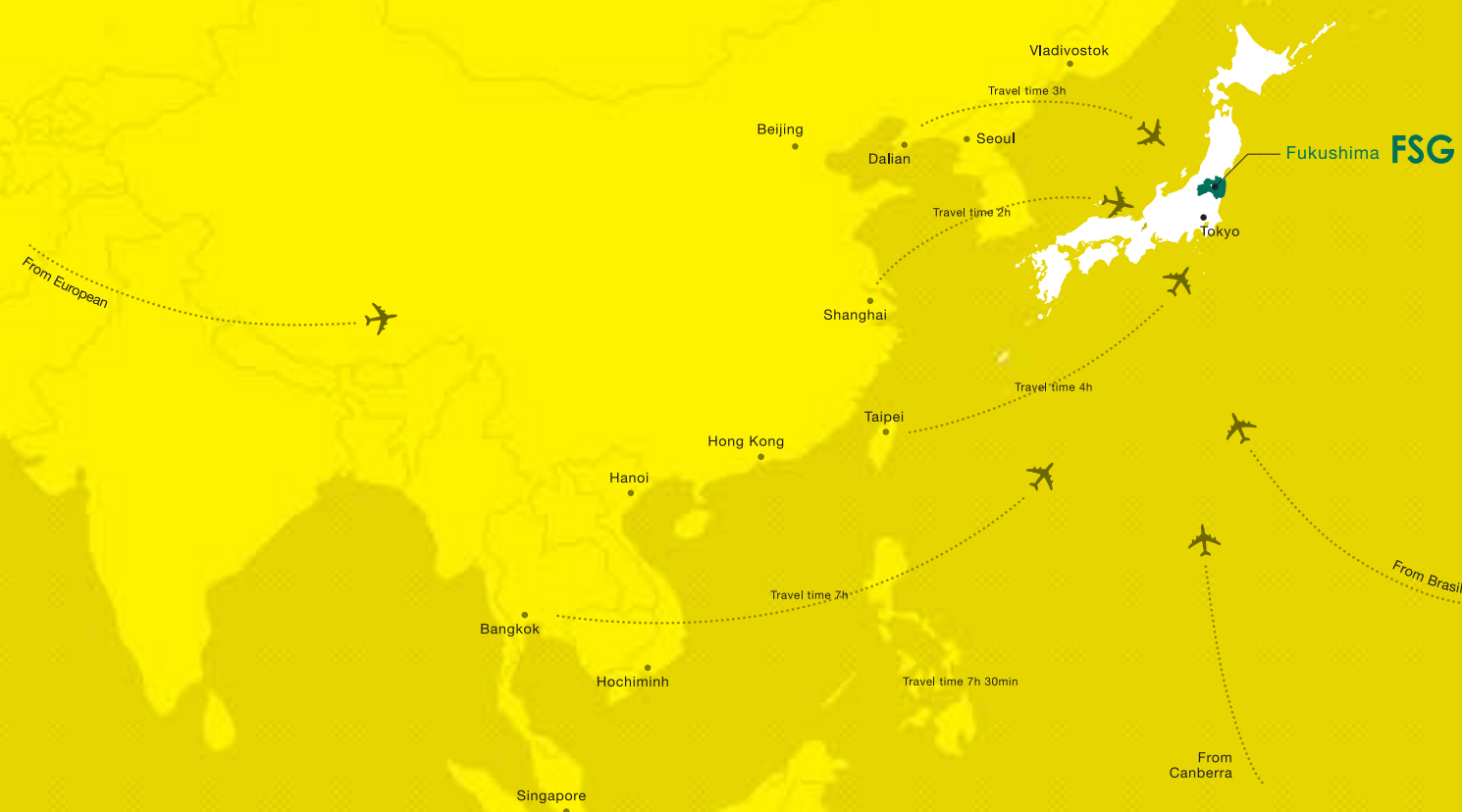
